- 1.5. Warringtonfire has top management commitment to impartiality. As a mechanism for safeguarding its impartiality, Warringtonfire has appointed an Impartiality Committee, which has been vested by the Directors of the company to ensure impartiality is maintained throughout all the schemes that Warringtonfire operates.
- 1.6. All personnel are committed to understanding this policy, complying with the principles and documentation, and maintaining continued competence.
- 1.7. Compliance with this policy and achievement of objectives will inspire confidence in all interested parties in the value, integrity, credibility, and trust of certificates issued by Warringtonfire.
